- To update and maintain state legislation pertaining to exotic, invasive noxious vegetation and their management.
- No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be for the carrying of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for office.
