



Pulling for Colorado - 2009 Grant Application Specifications

For All Projects

1. Before completing this application, please read the guidelines.
2. Focus will be on July 11, 2009.
3. Projects may occur anytime during April-October 2009.
4. Priority will be given to hands-on education based events.
5. Priority will be given to projects focusing on weeds designated as eradication weeds.
6. Priority will be given to projects with at least a 50:50 match.
7. Funding will be limited to materials and services only. Funds may not be used for salary, mileage or overhead however these may be used as in-kind to help reach the minimum 50:50 match.
8. Funds will not be made available until copies of receipts are submitted with the final report. Only items identified on the application budget worksheet will be eligible for reimbursement.
9. The Pulling For Colorado grant program is intended to build partnerships that will help noxious weed awareness reach new audiences and support ongoing efforts throughout the state.

For All Funded Projects - Final Report

A final report shall be completed and submitted by November 1, 2009 and shall include the following information:

1. Conclusions, including a description of the value of the results to local noxious weed management needs
2. Copies of all receipts
3. An oral presentation of results may be requested

Small Grant - \$500 or less

1. Must plan to integrate an invasive plant education message into the event
2. Projects are not limited to weed removal. However if your project includes removal it needs to be focused on noxious weeds that respond to hand pulling, digging or cutting.
3. Must have the local governing body's endorsement (county or municipality weed manager's)
4. Participants must meet requirements for volunteering
5. Sponsoring group assumes responsibility for the project

Large Grant - \$501-\$1500

1. Must plan to integrate an invasive plant education message into the event
2. Projects are not limited to weed removal. However if your project includes removal it needs to be focused on noxious weeds that respond to hand pulling, digging or cutting.
3. Must have the local governing body's endorsement (county or municipality weed manager's)
4. Participants must meet the requirements for volunteering
5. Sponsoring group assumes responsibility for the project

To Apply for Sponsorship

1. Complete the 2009 Project Funding Application. Use the attached forms. One additional page may be attached.
2. Project applications must be submitted by January 30, 2009
