

Pulling for Colorado - 2008 Funding Application Specifications

For All Projects

1. Before completing this application, please read the guidelines
2. Focus on Weed Awareness Week 2008 (July 6-12)
3. Projects may occur anytime during April-October 2008
4. Priority will be given to hands-on events
5. Priority will be given to projects focusing on weeds designated as eradication weeds
6. Priority will be given to projects with at least a 50:50 match
7. Funds may not be made available until copies of receipts are submitted with the final report
8. The Pulling For Colorado small grant program is intended to build partnerships that will help noxious weed awareness reach new audiences and support ongoing efforts throughout the state.

For All Funded Projects - Final Report

A final report shall be completed and submitted by November 1, 2008 and shall include the following information:

1. Conclusions, including a description of the value of the results to the local noxious weed management needs
2. Copies of receipts
3. An oral presentation of results may be requested

Small to Medium Groups (5-35)

1. Projects with focus on noxious weeds that respond to hand pulling, digging or cutting
2. Must have the local governing body's endorsement (county or municipality weed manager's)
3. Participants must meet requirements for volunteering
4. Sponsoring group assumes responsibility for the project
5. Minimum of five participants
6. Must plan to integrate an invasive plant education message into the event

Large Groups (35+)

1. Projects that focus on noxious weeds that respond to hand pulling, digging or cutting
2. Area will not be adversely impacted by the activity
3. Must have the local governing body's endorsement (county or municipality weed manager's)
4. Participants must meet the requirements for volunteering
5. Sponsoring group assumes responsibility for the project
6. Must plan to integrate an invasive plant education message into the event
